### From Narita International Airport:

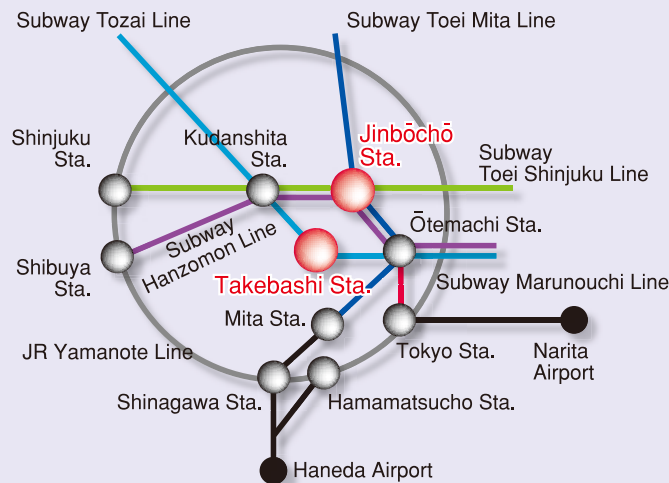
Take the Narita Express to Tokyo Station (approximately 60 minutes), walk to Otemachi Station (approximately 5 minutes), then take the Tokyo Metro Tozai Line to Takebashi Station. It is also possible to take the Mita Line from Otemachi Station to Jimbocho Station.

### From Haneda Airport:

Take the Keihin Kyuko Line to Mita Station (approximately 28 minutes); then change to the Mita Line and go to Jimbocho Station. Or take the TOKYO MONORAIL to Hamamatsucho. Then change to the JR Yamanote Line and go to Tokyo station, walk to Otemachi Station (approximately 5 minutes), then take the Tokyo Metro Tozai Line to Takebashi Station. It is also possible to take the Mita Line from Otemachi Station to Jimbocho Station.
